Definition:


“Certified Pool Operator” shall mean a person who demonstrates knowledge of pool operation and has shown proficiency of the safe and effective operation and maintenance of pool water through passing a test that is part of a certified pool training program


Article 8: Safety Requirements: Supervision;


Each pool facility shall have at least one employee or retain the services of a professional who shall demonstrate knowledge of pool operation and has shown proficiency of required information through passing a test that is part of a certified pool training program. Proof of certification shall be made available to the Health Officer upon request. The certification must be renewed whenever required but not more than a period of five years.
